

Closed Session
Jo Daviess County Board Meeting
April 10, 2017

The board entered closed session at 8:22 p.m. to discuss:

Personnel section 2(c)1

"The appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance, or dismissal of specific employees of the public body or legal counsel for the public body, including hearing testimony on a complaint lodged against an employee of the public body or against legal counsel for the public body to determine its validity." Topics of discussion: EMA Coordinator, Legal Services Manager, CVB Marketing Manager

Present were Steve Allendorf, Brandon Behlke, Maryanne Bennett, Richard Dittmar, Randy Jobgen, John Lang, Steve McIntyre, John Schultz, Ron Smith, Scott Toot, LaDon Trost, Martin Werner, RJ Winkelhake and Don Zillig. Present: 14. Absent-Bill Bingham, Robert Heuerman and Don Hill. Absent: 3.

County Administrator Dan Reimer, State's Attorney John Hay and County Clerk Jean Dimke were also present.

County Administrator Dan Reimer told the board there were three request for re-classification of current job position within the County approved through Carlson Dettman.

Joh Hay explained the reclassification of the Office Manager/Legal Services Manager Position State's Attorney Office. John said he updated position description for Tammy Winter requested to make her an exempt employee not subject to over-time. He said she has direct supervision and he has money in the budget to allow this reclassification. He explained she would go from a grade 7, step 6 to a grade 8, step 4 with an hourly wage increase from \$19.70 to \$19.08 per hour.

Dan Reimer explained the reclassification of the Emergency Management Agency Coordinator Position and the updated position description which would allow Chuck Pederson to go from a grade 9, step 4 to a grade 12, step 1 with an hourly increase from \$20.40 to \$22.42 per hour. Dan explained this is a non-exempt position under 1,000 per year.

Dan Reimer explained the reclassification of the CVB Marketing Manager Position and the updated position description which would allow Lori Kinnaman to go from a grade 6, step 3 to a grade 8, step 1 with an hourly increase from \$15.49 to \$17.57 per hour.
